

## ERRATA – LIVING PLANET REPORT 2012

**Pages 47 and 48:** Figure 29: Changes made to the numbers on the scale and the position of the world average biocapacity line.

First label on the y axis (vertical): Change “2” to “5”

Second label on the y axis (vertical): Change “4” to “10”

Move the biocapacity line down so that it crosses the y axis at 1.8

**Page 12, 1<sup>st</sup> bullet point:** The word “almost” should precede “30 per cent”, to read: The global Living Planet Index declined by **almost** 30 per cent between 1970 and 2008.

**Page 12, 3<sup>rd</sup> bullet point:** The number “30” should be “31”, to read: The global temperate index increased by **31** per cent; however this disguises huge historical losses prior to 1970.

**Page 13, 2<sup>nd</sup> bullet point:** The words “less than” should be replaced by “only”, to read: **Only** a third of the world’s rivers that are longer than 1,000km are free flowing and without dams on their main channel.

**Page 22, first sentence:** The number “30” should be “31”, to read:

The tropical Living Planet Index declined by just over 60 per cent from 1970 to 2008, while the temperate Living Planet Index increased by **31** per cent over the same period (Figure 8).

**Page 46: Figure 27:** Total Biocapacity per country in 2008: In the key:

10 - **1,000** million - change 1,000 to **100** million

**Page 82, Pullout:** Should read: Of the approximately **177** rivers greater than 1,000 km in length in 1900, only **a third** remain free flowing

**Page 82, paragraph 2, line 2:** Should read: Of the approximately **177** rivers greater than 1,000km in length, only **a third** remain free flowing and without dams on their main channel (WWF, 2006a).
